

POSTER SUBMISSION GUIDELINE

Guideline to propose a poster contribution for NanoInnovation 2020:

- Prepare your abstract following the template provided at the end of this guideline
- Submit your abstract online at www.nanoinnovation2020.eu, within the deadline reported in the NanoInnovation website.
- Contribution must be of technical-scientific nature. Promotional material will be rejected.
- Abstracts will be selected by the Steering Committee, basing on compliance with conference themes and objectives.
- Late submissions might be refused due to limitation in the exhibition space.
- Acceptance will be communicated to authors following the deadline reported in the NanoInnovation website.
- Once you will receive the notification regarding acceptance of your contribution please register to the Conference following the online procedure on the Conference website.
- A limited number of posters will be selected also for presentations and “flash presentations” in technical-scientific symposia or in dedicated Poster Sessions. Authors are requested to indicate in the submission form their availability for a presentation.
- Posters will be displayed in the main Conference Hall (same place of coffee breaks, lunches and exhibition).
- Poster will be displayed through the whole day during the event. Authors are free to manage their presence at the poster stand. Breaks between Scientific Symposia and Coffee breaks and lunch times are expected to be the most crowd moments in the day when most of delegates will likely visit the poster area.
- The poster must be in English and have the max. following dimensions: 70 cm (width) x 100 cm (height).
- The authors are responsible to bring and place their poster on the stand at the beginning of the Conference and to remove it at the end of the event.
- The list of poster contributions will be available on the NanoInnovation website and on the conference programme.
- *Presentation of a poster requires a registration fee of 100 euro + VAT. The corresponding invoice will be sent according to your indication in the online submission form. Payment must be done BEFORE the beginning of the event. No poster exhibition will be allowed without payment confirmation.*
