Prof. Dr. Anna Rita Bilia is associate professor at the University of Florence and Director of the Post-graduate School of Hospital Pharmacy.

In 1995 she got the national award "Claudio Redaelli" of the Italian Society of Phytochemistry for outstanding young researchers in the field of phytochemistry and in 2002 she got the international "Egon Stahl Medal" of the Society for Medicinal plant and natural product Research for researcher younger than 40 years, working in natural products. In 2018 she got the international "Quihung Prize" of the Academia of Chinese Medicine for her studies of quality control and innovative nanoformulations related to plants of the Traditional Chinese Medicine.
