

Dr. Daniela De Vita obtained her Master's degree in Pharmaceutical Chemistry & Technology at the University of Rome "Sapienza" (Italy) in 2004. In the same university, she started her doctorate program at the Department of Drug Chemistry & Technology. After receiving her doctorate in Pharmaceutical Sciences in 2008, she focused her activity on anti-Alzheimer, antifungal and antiparasitic agents (2008-2015).
