

How to access **NanoInnovation 2020**: instructions for in attendance participants

This year, due to the Covid-19 outbreak, access to NanoInnovation 2020 area conference will be restricted. In order to ensure the safety of all participants that have decided to follow the conference in attendance, please read carefully the instructions below.

BEFORE the conference, please:

- Download Immuni App on your mobile phone. In order to guarantee the tracking, all participants must take with them their mobile phone during the activities and have the Immuni app activated.
- To access Sapienza, external staff and visitors **must fill out the [form](#)** with all requested data. You will be asked to show the resulting PDF self-certification at the entrance of Sapienza location. During your stay at Sapienza you must follow the rules you can find on [Regulations](#) (in Italian language). In the form you can indicate:

- Fill in all its parts the [Responsibility Assumption Declaration](#) and show it at the entrance.

Without Immuni app, Self-certification from Sapienza and Responsibility Assumption Declaration, NO access will be allowed.

Before entering the conference spaces, one of our staff will measure the temperature. If the temperature exceeds 37,5 degrees, access will NOT be allowed.

DURING the conference, we ask you to observe the following rules:

- Sanitize your hands at the entrance of Sapienza Buildings with the disinfectants provided by the staff and wash your hands frequently using soap and water for 40 seconds, if soap is not available use hydroalcoholic solutions;
- Remember to always wear the mask to protect nose and mouth;
- Avoid close and prolonged contacts with people during activities and keep a distance of at least 1 meter;
- Avoid hugs, handshakes and direct physical contact with each person;
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands;
- Inform the Sapienza staff if during the conference flu or respiratory symptoms occur;
- Respect the security signs and the entrance and exit routes indicated;
- Observe all the rules defined by the competent emergency authorities COVID-19.
